

Dhaka-56.63 pc, Rajshahi-61.68 pc, Comilla 65.18 pc, Jessore-56.44 pc: Girls fare better with 60pc success in Rajshahi Board

The overall percentage of pass in the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations of 1987 under the four education boards of the country is 59.81, according to the results announced simultaneously on Wednesday.

A total of 3,60,502 candidates

had appeared at the examinations from Dhaka, Comilla, Rajshahi and Jessore education boards. Of them 2,15,609 came out successful with 35,862 in first division, 1,45,639 in second division and 34,108 in third division.

Boardwise the percentages of pass were 56.63 in Dhaka, 65.18

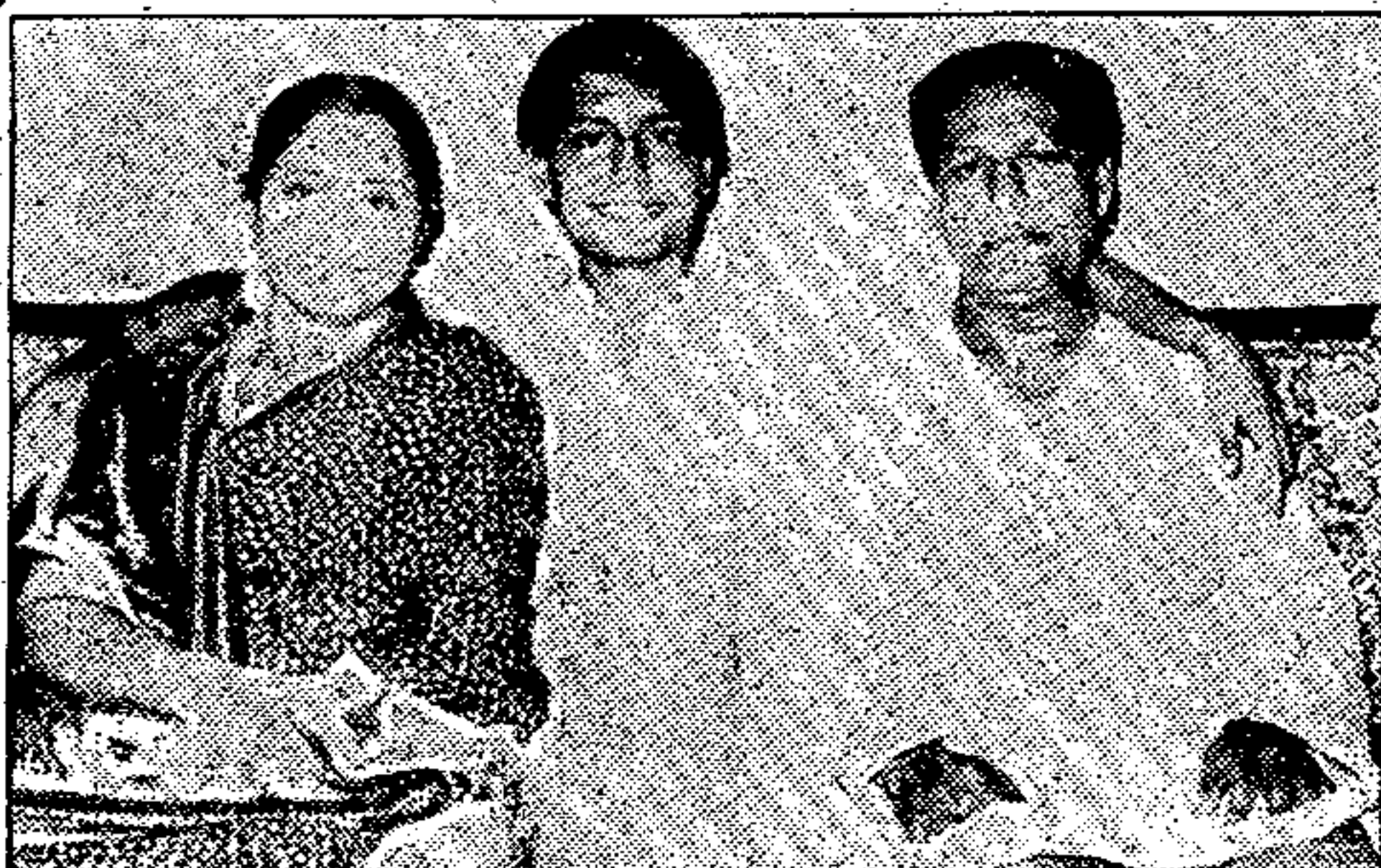
in Comilla, 61.68 in Rajshahi and 56.44 in Jessore.

Girls comprised 30.8 per cent of the total candidates under the four boards. A total of 66,226 girl candidates out of 1,11,174 passed the examinations, the percentage of pass being 59.57. Of them 8,552 were in First Division, 45,969 in Second Division and 11,705 in Third Division.

In Rajshahi Board the girl candidates fared better than the male candidates. The respective percentages of pass were 63.67 and 60.91.

This year the SSC candidates appeared under a unitrack system having two components, humanities and science. While the three boards of Comilla, Rajshahi and Jessore collated the results of humanities and
