

59.8 p.c. pass SSC exams

Results of the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) Examinations under four Boards of Intermediate and Secondary education at Dhaka, Comilla, Jessore and Rajshahi were announced on Wednesday.

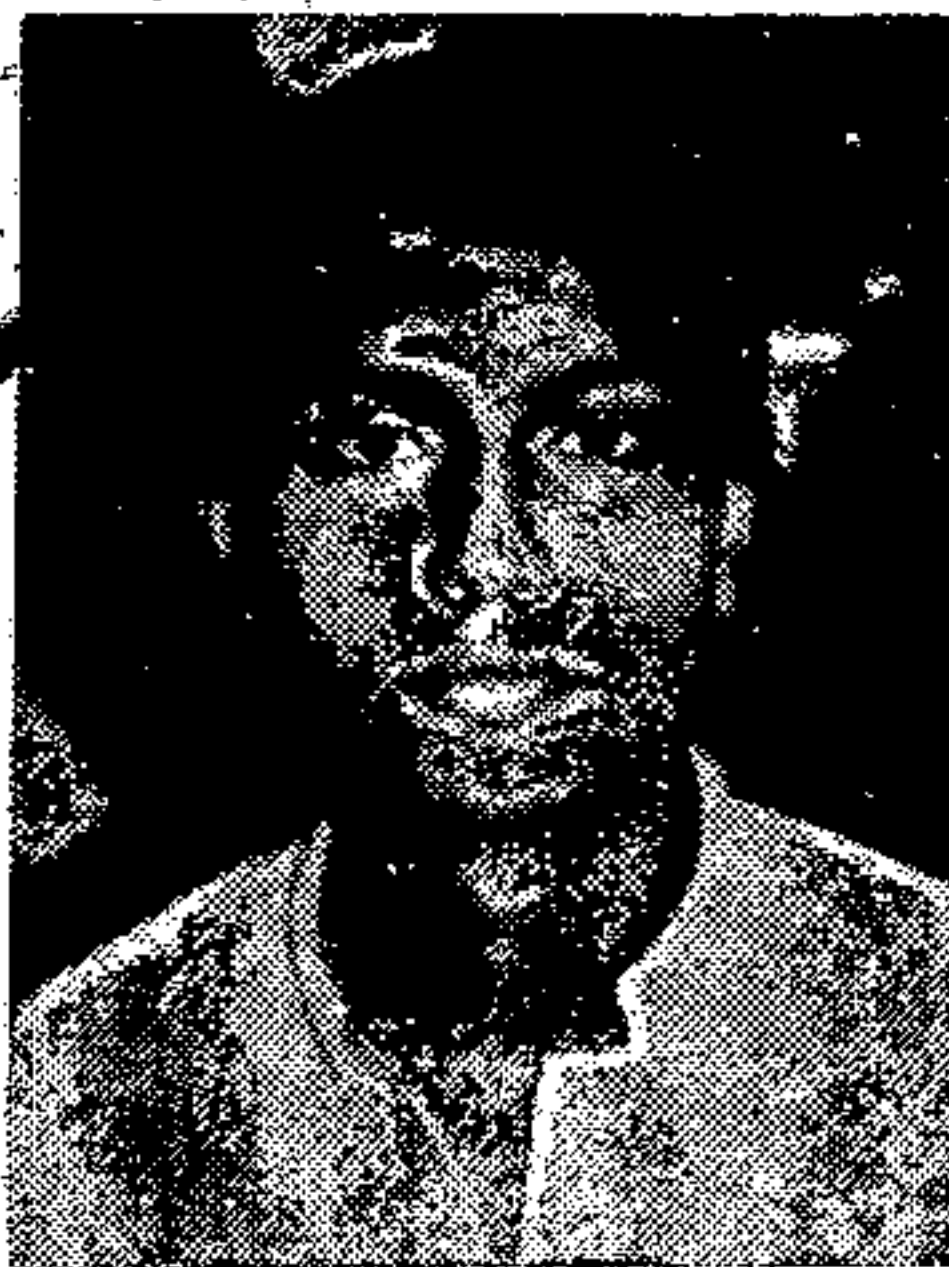
A total of 3,60,502 examinees appeared at the SSC Examination under the four Boards of which 2,15,609 came out successful. The percentage of pass on the average from four boards is 59.8.

His two elder sisters—Sucharita Ahmad, is a second year student in Sylhet Medical College and Susmita Ahmad is waiting to get herself admitted into honours class while his youngest brother Rashed Moin is a student of class IV.

A total of 1,11,324 examinees appeared from Dhaka Board of which 63,046 came out successful. The percentage of pass is 56.63. Of the successful examinees, 10,180 secured First Division 43,237 got Second Division and 9629 secured Third Division. The total examinees included both regular and private.

From Comilla Board, a total of 85205 examinees appeared at the SSC Examination of which 55542 came out successful. The percentage of pass is 65.18. Of the successful examinees 8989 secured First Division, 38539 Second Division and 8023 Third Division. The examinees included both regular and private.

From Jessore Board a total of 78763 examinees appeared at the SSC examination of which 44,460

came out successful. Out of the successful examinees 8091 got First Division 29,909 Second Division and 6460 Third Division. The Examinees included both regular and private.

From Rajshahi Board 85210 examinees appeared at the SSC examination of which 52561 came out successful. The percentage of pass is 61.68. Out of the successful examinees 8602 secured First Division, 33963 Second Division and 9996 Third Division.
