Apart from reading he listens to music.

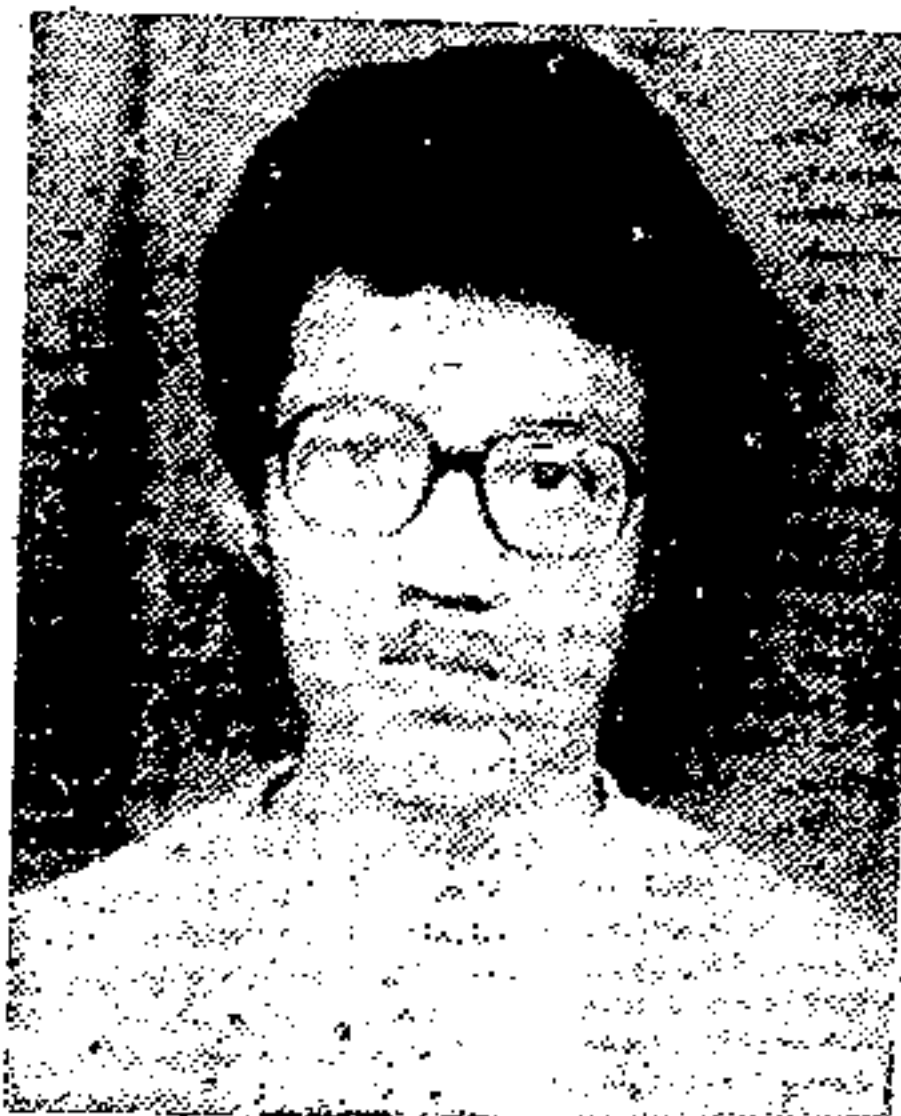


Ist among girls
