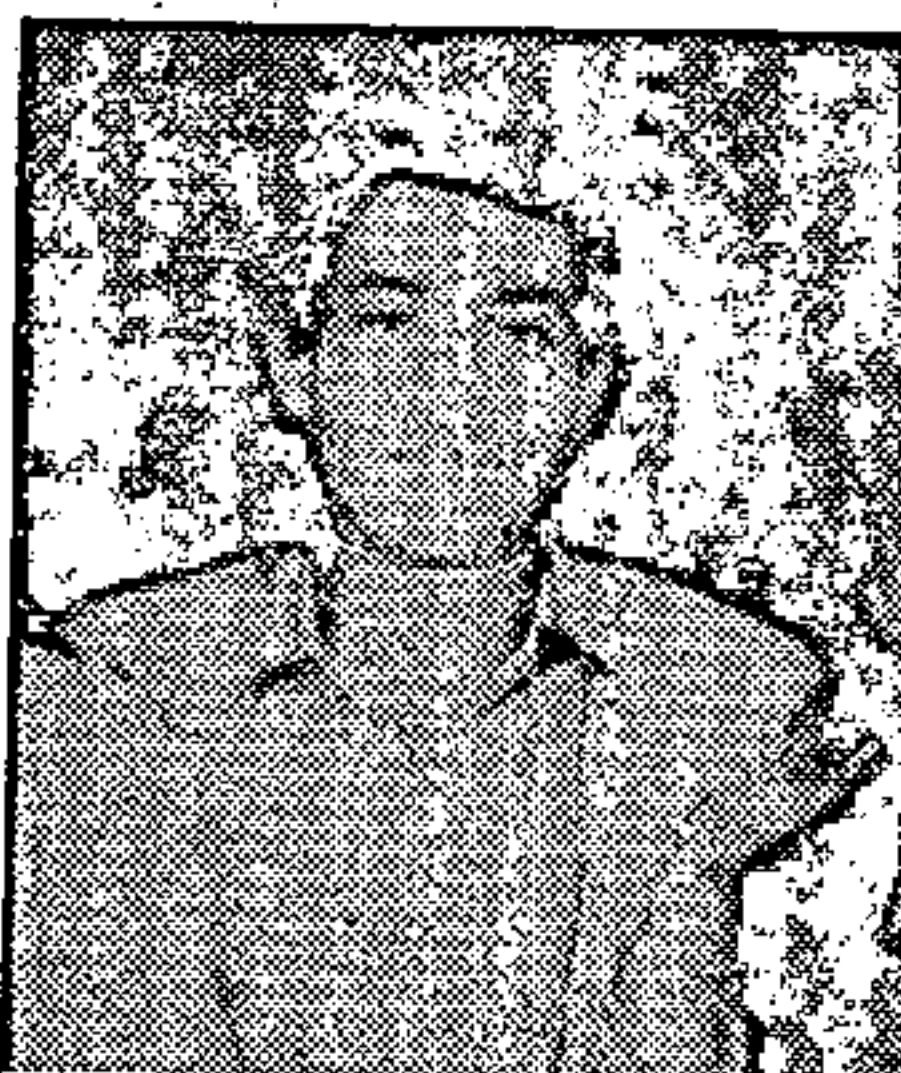
Golam Saklain secured 886 marks with letters in English, Mathematics, Geography, General Science, Elective Mathematics and Geometrical and Technical drawing.
