



90,111 SSC candidates from Jessore Board

JESSORE, March 13: A total of 90,111 examinees will appear in the Secondary School Certificate Examination 1989 of Jessore Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education beginning from March 16 from 100 centre in sixteen districts under Khulna Division.

These centres will be one each at upazila headquarters

and two cadet colleges and Dawood Public School and Shahen College at Jessore Cantonment.

Examinees include 36,061 in science group, 51,804 in humanities group and 2,246 private candidates. These examinees include 61,303 male and 28,808 female.

Meanwhile elaborate arrangements have been completed by respective district and upazila administration to hold the examination smoothly and to protect the examination centres from unfair means and corruption. Section 144 will be imposed around all examination centres to avoid any untoward incidents. The Chairman of Jessore Education Board Prof Gazi Abdus Salam is holding high level meetings with all district and upazila authorities and head of educational institutions for ensuring corruption-free examinations.
