SSC examinees defy Comilla Board order

COMILLA, July 17:—A total of 66 S.S.C. examinees of Rasulpur High School appeared at the examination in Burichong centre instead of Comilla Zila School centre defying the orders of BISE, Comilla. They changed the centre at the last moment without any valid reason, it is alleged.

According to reports, Rasulpur High School falls within Comilla Sadar Upazila and as per latest orders in the Ber andidates evere andidates

School centre. Rasulpur High School authority along with 5 other high schools applied to the Board to allow their candidates to sit in Burichang centre. The Board authority, rejected theri prayer vide exasecond 90/134/(3) dated 7.5.90, and directed Comilla Zilla School centre to arrange seats accordingly.

But lonly 4 examinees (Roll Com-422, 423, 424 and 1310) of Rasulpur High School turned up in Comilla Zilla School centre and rest 66 were found absent. Later SSC examinees at the Burichong centre.

This irregularity aggrieved the intellenctuals and S.S.C. examinces of the other five high schools and fre of found SSC exminces was hanging in the balance.
