Comilla, Jessore Boards SSC exams from Sunday

A total of 2,28,753 candidates will appear at the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination—1991 from Comilla and Jessore Education Boards, beginning on Sunday, reports UNB.

The examination, scheduled May 2 simultaneously in four boards of the country, was postponed in Comilla and Jessore boards following the devastating

cyclone of April 29.

When contacted, the Controllers of Examination of both Comilla and Jessore boards told UNB that necessary arrangements have been made in the cyclone battered areas for smooth holding of examinations along with other areas.

The educational institutions which were damaged by the cyclone and tidal surge have been repaired, they said.

A total of 1,30,240 candidates will appear from 131 centres of Comilla Board with one overseas centre in Saudi Arabia. Another 98,513 candidates will appear from 104 centres of Jessore Board.

The April 29 cyclone which hit greater Chittagong districts forced the authorities to postpone the examination in Comilla Board while Bhola, Barguna, Patuakhali and Barisal districts under Jessore Board were the worst hit.
