

Jessore, Comilla Board SSC exam from today

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination-1991 of Jessore and Comilla Education Boards, which was earlier postponed due to April 29 cyclone and tidal surge, begins today (Sunday) official sources said.

A total 2,28,753 candidates of the two boards are appearing in the examination. Of them 98,513 candidates are appearing from 105 centres of Jessore Board, and 1,30,240 from 131 centres of Comilla Board with one overseas centre in Saudi Arabia, the Chairman of the Jessore Board and the Controller of Comilla Board separately told BSS on Saturday.

The examinations of Dhaka and Rajshahi Boards were held earlier as scheduled from May 2.

The sources told BSS that necessary arrangements had been made in the cyclone battered areas for smooth holding of examinations along with other areas of the two boards.

The educational institutions which were damaged by the cyclone and tidal bore have been repaired, they said.

Even in the case of damaged or unfit centres for holding the examinations in the cyclone-hit areas alternate arrangements have also been made, the source added.
