42.45 pc pass Dhaka Board HSC exams

The Dhaka Education Board on Saturday announced the results of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations held this year. The percentage of pass is 42.45, reports BSS.

A total of 65,188 students out of 1,53,551 came out successful in the successful in the examination.

Of the successful candidates 15,886 got First Division, 38,138 Second Division and 11,164 Third Division.

In all 96,873 male and 56,678 female students appeared in the examinations in the groups of (a) Science, Agriculture and Home Economics (b) Humanities, Islamic Studies and Music and (c) Commerce. The percentage of successful male and female students are 42.04 and 43.17 respectively.

In the Science Group 20,680 male and 7,832 female students appeared while 12,618 male and 5,030 female student came out successful. In the Humanities Group 50,209 male and 45,384 female appeared while 16,650 male and 7,441 female passed and in the Commerce Group 25,984 male 3,402 female appeared while 11,454 male and 1,995 female came out successful.

The percentage of pass in the Science Group is 61.90, in the Humanities 35.66 and in the Commerce Group 45.67.

In the Science Group at total of 8,425 students got First Division, 8496 Second Division and 727 Third Division. In the Humanities Group 4,119 students

passed in the First Division, 21,113 in the Second Division and 8,859 in the Third Division. In Commerce Group 3,342 students got First Division, 8,529 Second Division and 1,578 Third Division.

In the Combined Merit List in Science Group Ashfaq Rahman of Dhaka College stood first securing 967 marks, while Mohammad Ahsanul Adecb and Khandaker Mohammad Istiak of Dhaka College jointly stood second securing 958 marks each and Mohammad Khairul Islam of the same college stood third with 952 marks.

In Humanities group Nadia Rawshan of Rifles Public School stood first securing 910 marks, Mohammad Delwar Hossain of Dhaka College second securing 888 marks and Mohammad Amir Hossain of Syed Abul Hossain College stood third securing 885 marks.

In Commerce Group Humaira Matin and Rabeya Begam of Dhaka Commerce College and Viqarunnissa Noon College jointly stood first securing 847 marks each, James Bakul Sarker of Dhaka City College stood second securing 840 marks and Tanzina Haque of Dhaka Commerce College stood third with 836 marks.

In the Combined Merit List of female students Sohana Tanzem of Viqarunnissa Noon College stood first in the Science Group securing 850

marks, Nadia Afroze Ahmed of the same college stood second securing 945 marks and Asrafun Nahar of Sarishabari Razuddin Talukder College stood third securing 939 marks.

In Humanities group Nadia Rawshan of Rifles Public College stood first securing 910 marks, Farhana Ahmed Chowdhury of Viqarunnissa Noon College stood second securing 876 marks and Jamila Ahmed Chowdhury of Myrmensingh Girls' Cadet College stood third securing 869 marks.

In Commerce Group Humaira Matin of Dhaka Commerce College and Rabeya Begum of Viqarunnissa Noon College jointly stood first securing 847 marks each Tanzina Haque of Dhaka Commerce College stood second securing 836 marks and Shami Akter of Viqarunnissa Noon College stood third securing 821 marks.
