74.40 pc pass Dhaka Board SSC examinations

The results of the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations held this year under the Dhaka Education Board were announced on Tuesday.

A total of 2,35,829 students appeared in the examination of whom 1,75,453 came out successful. Of the total successful candidates, 94,489 obtained first division, 78,135 second division and 2,829 third division. The overall pass percentage is 74.40.

Mohammad Abdur Rahim Musta-

fa of Ideal High School and Shamima Sarmin Kanta of Mohammadpur Preparatory And Girls' High School jointly topped the combined merit list in science group securing 898 marks. Both got distinction in seven subjects.

The second place went to Ehsanul Islam of Ideal High School and third position jointly to Nabil Imran Siddique of Government Laboratory High School and Samuel Sanjay Rema of St. Joseph High School. Ehsan got 897 marks with distinction in seven

subjects while both Nabil Imran and Samuel Sanjay secured 895 marks with distinction in seven subjects.

In Social Science Group, H.S. Tareq Ahmed of Khilgaon Government High School topped the combined merit list obtaining 864 marks with letter marks in seven subjects.

Sanjida Hossain Ripa of Ideal High School got second position securing 859 marks with distinction in seven subjects. Azizun Nessa of Viqarunnesa Noon School secured third position bagging 856 marks and seven letters.

In the Science Group, 69,033 students out of 79,117 came out successful. The percentage of pass is 87.25. Out of the successful candidates of this group 48,111 are males and 20,922 females. The percentage of pass for male candidates being 87.02 and for female examinees is 87.79.

From Social Science group, 106,420 students appeared in the examination of whom 156,712 came out successful. The percentage of pass of this group is 67.91.
