## 775 appearing HSC exam without admit cards

SIRAJGANJ, May 15 : A total of 775 students have been appearing at the HSC examination without admit cards in the five examination centres of the district, official sources said here, reports UNB.

The principals of Sirajgonj Government College and Rashidujzoha Government Girls College said 590 admit cards not collected by the students were lying with them but they were appearing at the same examination in different centres.

The 775 students who are appearing without admit cards were found in the centres at Tenglahata College of Kazipur, Solonga of Raiganj, Dhonegora and Chandaikona Colleges, Chouhali and Satbaria colleges.

Principal Tusher Kumer Bhadra said irregularities were being committed in connivance with some unscrupulous Board officials.

Deputy Commissioner AKM Shamsuddin said he had served notice to the principals for calling

he Bagbati and Solonga degree College centres for adopting unfair means in the HSC exam.

The DC said he received reports on unfair practices from 23 centres of the total 28 HSC exam centres, except 4 centres in the town and Ullapara Science College centres.
