Dacoity at Nilphamari town

Fake SSC, HSC certificates, marksheets recovered

NILPHAMARI, Nov. 3:—Dacoity was committed in a house at Nilphamari town on November 1. The dacoits looted cash, gold ornaments and household goods worth about Tk. 60,000 and beat the house owner.

A gang of dacoits entered the house of one Majnu and looted cash, gold ornaments and house-hold goods worth about Taka 60,000. The dacoits beat the house owner Majnu.

One Habib was caught red-handed while he was snatching taka one lakh from a bank at Saidpur on October 27.

Mr. Omar Ali, proprietor of Sani Flower Mill of Saidpur went to Basic Bank at Saidpur town for depositing Taka one lakh in his account. At that time three snatchers took his bag into possession when the bank guard and nearby people caught hold one Habib with the bag. The other two snatchers managed to escape. Habib is an inhabitant of Sonadanga thana under Khulna district.

Saidpur police arrested two persons on the charge of making fake certificates, marksheets testimonials and tabulation sheets of SSC and HSC Examinations on October 28. Police recovered some pads and seals of different colleges.

One Kawsar Ahmed of Golahat under Saidpur town has been making fake certificates, marksheets, testimonials and tabulation sheets of SSC and HSC Examinations and sold these fake certificates for a long time and earned a huge amount of money.

On getting a secret information

Iqbal Safi, Officer-in-Charge of Saidpur Police Station with a number of constables raided the house of Kawsar Ahmed, who managed to escape. Police recovered some fake pads and seals of different colleges. Police arrested Badsha Mia and Ataur Rahman who are accomplices of Kawsar Ahmed.

A case has been filed with local police station in this connection.

Police recovered one country made pipe-gun and 4 live bullets on October 20 from a shrine.

On getting a secret information police raided an old shrine at village Kundal under Saidpur thana and recovered one country made pipe-gun and 4 live cartridges.

Bagerhat

Our Bagerhat Correspondent reports: A daring dacoity was committed in the house of one Palash Khan of village Baliadanga under Fairhat thana recently.

A gang of 7/8 armed dacoits raided the house and looted cash, gold ornaments and other valuables worth Taka one lakh at gun point.

In this connection a case was registered with Fakirhat PS U/S 394 of BPC.

One Zahid Mallick a young man who was seriously injured by a gang of armed miscreants at Jatrapur-Kaliadair area under Bagerhat Sadar thana is now fighting with death in P.G. Hospital, Dhaka.

The miscreants kidnapped him and took him to a betelnut garden, a adjacent to Bishnupur village and inflicted severe cut injuries with sharp knives, due to previous enmity. He was at first admitted to local hospital and removed to P.G. Hospital.

One Hemayet Hossain of village Tafalbaria under Sharankhola thana was electrocuted when he touched a leaf of a banana tree which was electrified in a betel-nut garden on October 28.
