HSC exam incidents

Injured teachers to get financial assistance

Education Minister A.S.H.K. Sadek on Sunday highly appreciated the teachers, officials of the administration and members of the law enforcing agencies for discharging their duties with courage during the first two days of the Higher Secondary Certificate examination, reports BSS.

"The nation feels proud of them", Mr. Sadek said in a statement in Dhaka.

The Education Minister said that an evil clique had long been engaged to destroy the educational system. He urged all students, guardians and the teachers to unitedly resist the clique out to destroy the country's education.

Mr. Sadek announced that financial assistance would be provided to those teachers who were injured or otherwise affected by the outsiders and copyists while discharging their duties with honesty. He said the responsibility of ensuring fair examinations

within the examination centres vests on the teachers.

He said departmental actions would be taken on the basis of primary report against those teachers who had failed to perform their responsibilities.

Mr. Sadek said that the government would not allow to destroy the main objective of the examination.

Necessary steps, he said, would be taken so that the outsiders and the copyists could not influence the examination system.
