

## Over 1000 more SSC examinees expelled

Over one thousand examinees were expelled from different centres on charge of adopting unfair means in the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations on Saturday.

According to board officials, Bengali second paper examination was held on the second day of the examination on Saturday and no report of any untoward incident was received from any centre.

The highest 574 candidates were expelled from different centres under Rajshahi Board, followed by Comilla Board 186, Dhaka Board 158, Chittagong Board 20 and Jessore 10.

The Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examinations under the country's five educational boards began on Thursday. A total of 7.42 lakh students—4.30 lakh boys and 3.11 lakh girls—are sitting for the examination which is being held with the same set of question papers for the first time this year.
