Preparations for HSC exams taken

Necessary preparations have been taken for the peaceful conduct of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination which will begin on May 8, according to an official handout in Dhaka on Monday, says BSS.

Preparations have also been taken to take punitive measures against those who would spread rumour of leakage of question papers through fake question papers and for adopting unfair means in the examination halls.

On the basis of first enquiry report for association with the leakage of question papers in the last SSC examination, three assistant teachers of Chakoria Government Boys High School in Cox's Bazar district have been suspended and criminal cases were filed against them, the handout said.

On the same complaint government contribution to the salaries and allowances of a teacher of Shah Umrabad High School in Chokoria thana and the headmasters of Bahad-darkati High School and Darbesh-kata High School have been postponed until further order.

Government contribution to the salaries and allowances of seven teachers which include the headmaster of Haluaghat Gabria-juri High School, senior teacher of Haluaghat High School and St Adrose High School, Biroy Dakuni High School, Haluaghat Girls' High School in Mymensingh district also have been postponed until further order.

The Education Ministry has directed the managing committees of the schools to take departmental

actions against these teachers.

Government salaries and allowances of nine teachers of Hatkhola High School, Raipur High School, Nabagram High School, Jagatpur Sadhana High School, Gazipur Khan High School and Gauripur Girls' High School in Daudkandi thana under Comilla district have been postponed for six months for alleged negligence and failure in duties in the examination halls. Besides, they have been restricted in performing duties as invigilators in the examination halls till next year.

Departmental cases have been filed against a thana magistrate who was in-charge of Chokoria centre in Cox's Bazar district and an Assistant Commissioner who was in-charge of Haluaghat centre in Mymensingh district.

The Education Ministry has sought cooperation of the students, teachers, guardians and the mass media in fair and proper conduct of the coming HSC examinations.
