



Vo candidates from 25 colleges pass B Com (Pass) exam

No candidates from as many as 25 colleges under the Uniof Dhaka passed the versity B.Com. (pass) examination of 1986. The results of the examination announced on may 2 show that the percentage of pass in B.Com. (pass) examination was 34.2...

The percentage of pass in B.Sc. (pass) examination of the same year under DU was 47.96. Two colleges failed to have any of their candidates passed the examination, according to the results.

A total of 5,842 candidates had appeared at the B.Com. (pass) examination from 127 colleges. Of them 1,998 passed the examination with two in first division, 323 in second division and 1,673 in third division.

It is interesting to note the difference existing among the colleges in terms of performance as far as the percentage of pass is concerned.

examina-In B.Com. (pass) tion the percentage of pass attained by the colleges varied from cent per cent to 3.7 per cent. The results show that the Sharisabari College Jamalpur and the Terasree College, Terasree attained cent per cent pass: These two colleges, however, had sent up only one candidate each.

They were followed by the Bahrampur College, Bahrampur with 88.9 percentage of pass, Bhandaria Govt. College (84.2. per cent), and Boalmari College Boalmari (83.3 per cent).

But the percentage of pass was only 3.7 for Gaffargaon Govt. College, Gaffargaon; 5.4 Ibrahim Khan College, Bhuapur, and 6.3 for the Shere-Bangla College, Barisal.

....In-B.Com: (Pass)-examination: the overall percentage of pass was a bit higher (47.96). Out of 6,201 candidates who appeared in it 2,974 came out successful with six in first division, 1,187

in second division and 1,776 in third division. Two colleges out of 52 failed to have their canexamination.
