pc pass HSC exams

By A Staff Reporter Results of HSC examinations were announced this year simultaneously by all the four education boards on Thursday with the national average of rate of success at 43,21 per cent.

According to official statistics, a total of 2,97,120 candidates including 79,800 appeared at the examinations this year. Of them 1,31,031 came out successful.

Of the total 51,939 students passed from the Dhaka Board, 6,957 got First Division 32,939 secured Second Division and 12,043 got Third Division.

The announcement said HSC examinations were held in 601 centres including two foreign centres. The number of centres under Dhaka Board was 157 while Comilla-131, Raj. shahi—167 and Jessore—146. The highest rate of 57.75 per

tics, the largest number of 89 940 candidates appeared from Dhaka Board and 76,017 from Rajshahi Board. The figures of the candidates in Jessore and Comilla Boards were 65,659 and 65,504 respectively.

Of the successful candidates girls fared better than boys in Dhaka, Comilla and Jessore Boards. However in Rajshahi Board performance of boys was better than the girls




