The results of the Higher Secondary Certificate examination Incld under Dhaka, Comilla, Rajshahi and Jessore boards during June and Julywere published on 10th Novem ber, 1988. The delay was obvious which was due to the devastating flood. "The result was disappointing for the nation.

A total of 2,97,120 candidates (out of which 2,17,320 were male and the rest 79,800 female) appeared in the examinations from four boards of whom 1,31,031 came out successful which shows that the percentage of the successful candidates is 44,10. The distri-

bution of candidates' appeared. in the examination and those who have passed is shown in the following table.

Among the successful candidates the results are not same for all the students. The percentage of students obtaining first division is very low. compared to second and third division. The undermentioned table No. If gives the divisionwise distribution of successfull candidates of the four boards.

The above table shows that the concentration of successfull candidates is in the second

di vision bracket campared to that of first and third division. This observation is valid all the four bodies. The highest percentage of the who came out candidates successful in the second division indicate that mediocre students constitute the major share of our students community.
