and one each from Sheikh Borhanuddin College and Siddheshwari College.

A total of 135 students were expelled from Tangail, 274 in Jamalpur, 25 in Sherpur, 86 in Netrokona, 158 in Mymensingh 82 in Gopalganj, 22 in Shariatpur, 32 in Madaripur, 99 in Kishoreganj, 122 in Narsingdi, 58 in Manikganj, 99 in Munshiganj, 14 in Gazipur and 153 in Narayanganj districts.

Our Mymensingh Correspondent reports: Police opened three rounds of fire in the sky at Ananda Mohon Government College centre when some examinees tried to foil the examination demanding shifting of the centre of their respective college. A total of 141 examinees walked out of the centre.

Our Comilla Correspondent reports: One hundred and five examinees were expelled from different centres in Comilla district and 184 in Chandpur district. Police opened fire in the sky at Daudkandi centre to disperse a mob which tried to supply copies to the examinees. Two policemen were injured as they were brickbatted. Police picked up three persons from the spot.

Our Jessore Correspondent reports: A total of 210 students were expelled from 10 centres in Jessore district. An Assistant Professor was expelled from Nawapara College Centre.

Our Khulna Correspondent reports: Eighty four candidates were expelled from different centres in Khulna city. Of them 51 were expelled from Khulna City College.

Our Barisal Correspondent reports: Five hundred and 97 candidates were expelled from different centres in Barisal district. No untoward incident was reported.

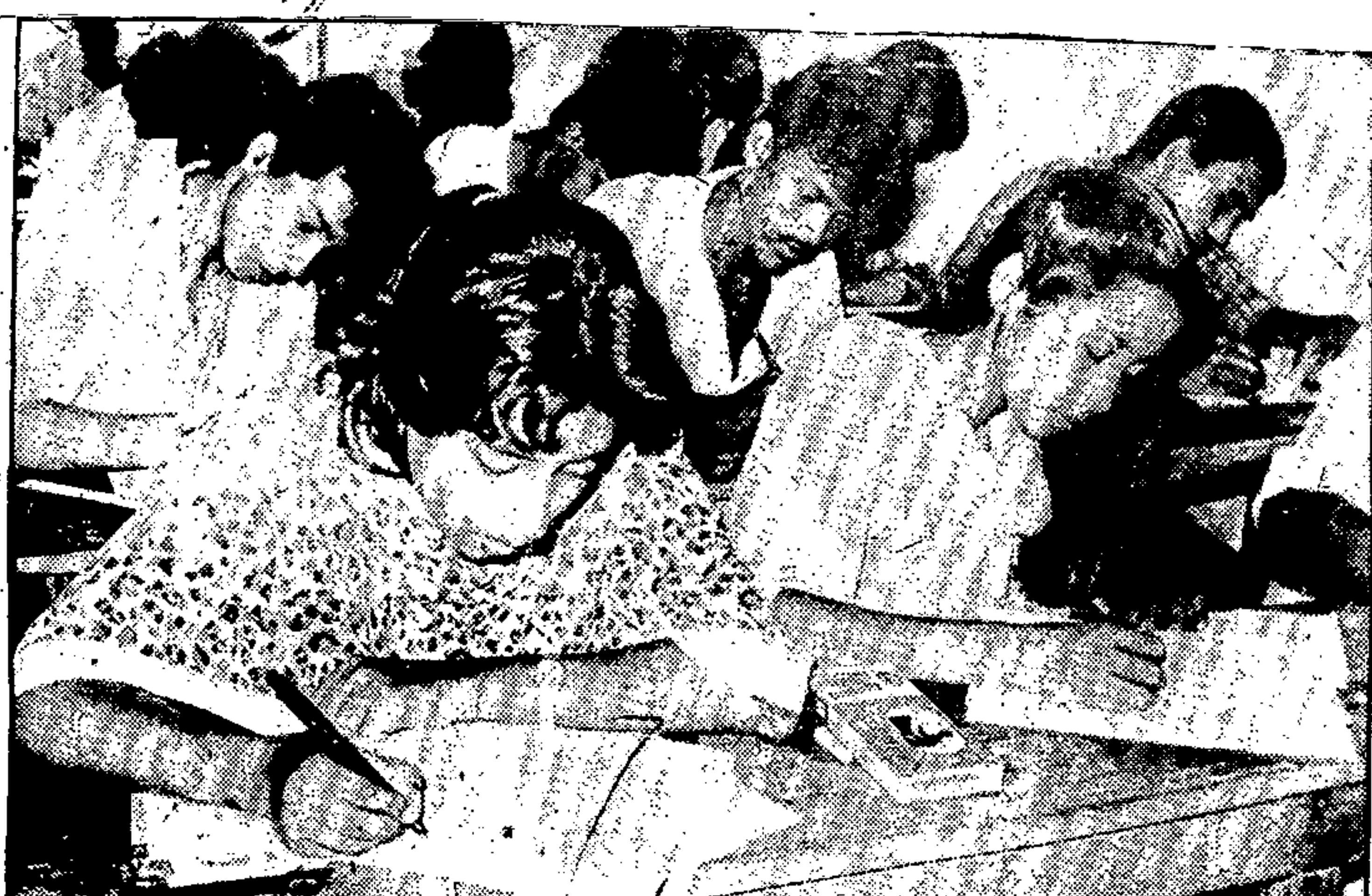
Our Kushtia Correspondent reports: Eighty one candidates were expelled from different centres in Kushtia district on Thursday for adopting unfair means.

Our Satkhira Correspondent reports: Three hundred candidates remained absent from the examination centre at Satkhira during the Bangla second paper examination on Thursday afternoon.

Our Rajshahi Correspondent reports: Over 600 examinees were expelled from different centres in Rajshahi, Natore and Bogra districts. Of them 181 were from nine upazilas of Rajshahi, 33 from Natore and 398 from Bogra districts. In Rajshahi city two candidates were expelled from Rajshahi city college, 16 from Lokonath High School centre and one from Rajshahi Women's College.

One teacher was expelled from Godagari Centre for helping some examinees in adopting unfair means.

Our Rangpur Correspondent reported expulsion of 55 students from different centres in the district. Our Gaibandha Correspondent reported expulsion of 218 examinees in the district.

HSC exam begins 4,100 expelled on first day

Over 4100 examinees and two invigilators were expelled on the first day of the Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination 1989 of the four education boards on Thursday for adopting unfair means.

According to reports received in Dhaka till midnight last night 1801 examinees were expelled from different centres in Dhaka Board, 885 in Rajshahi Board, 379 in Comilla Board and 888 in Jessore Board.

One invigilator was expelled from Godagari in Rajshahi and another one from Nawapara College in Jessore for helping examinees in adopting unfair means

in the examinees in the examination.

The examination was held peacefully on the first day barring stray incidents at Mymensingh and Daudkandi.

Dhaka Board officials said, five students were expelled from three centres in Dhaka city. Of them three were expelled from Shaheed Suhrawardy College
