## Dhaka Board to reschedule HSC examination

The Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Dhaka, yesterday decided to reschedule the time-table of the Higher Secondary Examination, 1989 which will begin on June 8.

According to a reliable source the Board authorities are finalising the programme and it will be published through newspapers in a day or two.

The programme is being rescheduled following demonstrations by examinees demanding gap between examination of different subjects.

According to the earlier announced schedule, the examination was to begin on June 8 and end on June 27.

the new programme to create gap between the holding of examination of some subjects. Last year the HSC examination spread over 23 days. Board authorities this year reduced the number of days of HSC examination with a view to reduce the expenses of the candidates who live in hired houses during the examination and also to reduce the closure days of the institutions which are used as examination centres.

But the Dhaka Board authorities had to go for readjustment as the examination programme with shorter or no gap between different subjects gave rise to resentment among candidates and concern among the guardians.
