HSC exams begin tomorrow

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations under four boards of the country will begin tomorrow.

This year, a total of 3,22,993 examinees including about 89,000 girls will appear.

in the ensuing HSC examinations at 511 centres. The number of examination centres has been reduced this year by 100 with a view to checking unfair means in the examinations. The trend of copying in the examinations of both SSC and HSC increased alarmingly in the previous years.

In the HSC examinations of 1989 in all 95,030 students appeared at 134 centres under Dhaka Board, 75,170 at 118 centres under Comilla Board, 66,705 at 128 centres under Jessore Board and 86,734 at 140 centres under Rajshahi Board.

Meantime, the Education Minister, Dhaka University Vice-Chancellor, leaders of a number of teachers' associations and student organisations separately, called all concerned to resist copying in the HSC examinations begin tomorrow.

Meanwhile, Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner at a press release last night imposed a ban on movement of four or more persons around 200 yards of 24 HSC examination centres of the city. The order would come into effect from tomorrow till July 3.
