Time table of HSC exams to be recast

A high level meeting of the Education Ministry held here yesterday decided that in future no one would be permitted to sit for any examination under special private category and that all private students would have to appear in their examinations from the district centres only, reports BSS.

The meeting, chaired by Education Minister Sheikh Shahidul Islam, took the decision to make the education system more progressive and welfare oriented.

The meeting also decided to reconsider the question of keeping those schools as centres for future examinations where excessive unfair means were adopted in past years.

a number of decisions on the schools, admitting fake students and encouraging cheating in examinations, including stoppage of grants and withdrawal of government recognition. Decision was taken to check giving registration to fake students.

The meeting reviewed the holding of the coming Higher Secondary Certificate examinations and decided that there would be not more than one examination centre in one upazila and centres would be set up after discussions between Board authorities and district administrations.

The meeting also decided to recast the time-table for the coming H.S.C. examinations, including breaks. But, it also considered the short duration of examinations for the benefit of the rural students.

The minister told BSS that the final time-table would be announced shortly after the authorities of the four boards discussed in details on the subject.

The meeting was attended by Education Secretary Hedyat Ahmed additional secretary of the ministry, chairmen of the four education boards, Madrasa Education and Technical Education Board and concerned high officials.
