

Invigilators at Degree exam centre assaulted

KURIGRAM, May 23:—The Degree Examination in Ulipur College centre in Kurigram ended in a fiasco due to quarrel between invigilators and examinees in the examination hall. Four invigilators were assaulted by the examinees in the halls as they prevented them from copying.

The examination on the fourth day began in due time. But after about 20 minutes the examinees started copying when the invigilators, who went there from Kurigram, prevented them from copying. At this time some unruly examinees attacked the invigilators and drove them out of the hall. At the time of incident the examinees also took away the answer scripts from the hall. No magistrate and UNO were present at that time in the centre.

Out of total 225 answer scripts supplied on the day 135 were recovered and the rest 90 were missing, the office-in-charge of the centre said.

On hearing this Mr. Mojibar Rahman ADC, Kurigram, went there with police force and rescued the invigilators and brought them to Kurigram.

The assaulted invigilators are Mr. Abdul Halim, Mr. Abdul Quader of Kurigram Govt. College, Mr. Abdul Matin, Mr. Mahabbat Ali Sardar of Kurigram Mahila College. The conditions of Mr. Abdul Quader is stated to be critical. He was admitted into Kurigram hospital.

Meanwhile, the Rajshahi University authority has closed the Ulipur college centre from the 4th day of degree examination. The centre has been shifted to Kurigram Mahila College centre on May 19 where 20 examinees of Ulipur College appeared in the examination in Islamic History and Culture first paper.

On the otherhand, the examination in Kurigram Govt. College centre (boys college) has still been conducting by the govt officials and magistrates from the fifth day of examination. The teachers are abstaining from performing their invigilation work due to unpleasant incident took place at Ulipur College centre between invigilators and examinees.

Meanwhile, three examinees in Political Science and three examinees in Islamic History and Culture have been expelled by Mr. Nural Islam, Upazila Magistrate, Kurigram Sadar.
