

Withdrawal of degree exam centre resented

COX'S BAZAR: Dec. 27: Students of Cox's Bazar Govt, College boycotted their classes December 20 in protest against the cancellation degree centre.

In a procession they paraded the streets of the town chanting various slogans and submitted a memorndum to the Deputy Commissioner demanding reinstalment of degree centre.

The Deputy Commissioner assured them that their demand would be communicated to relevant authorities.

Govt College Students Union in a Press conference at Press Club expressed grave concern over the order of cancellation of degree centre and shifting to Satkania College. They said that it will be quite difficult on the part of about 700 examinees to appear at Satkania College centre in these days of economic crisis.

This decision will force the examinees to drop their studies, they added.

In the meantime leaders of Chatra of Oikka Parishad met local journalists and apprised them of the problem.

The local students, guardians, political leaders and elite have appealed to the authority for the reinstalment of degree centre at Cox's Bazar.
