

HSC exams from today

Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examination-1991 under three of the country's four education boards begins today (Thursday) says UNB.

More than 200,000 candidates are appearing at the examination from Dhaka, Rajshahi and Jessore boards, while the exam under Comilla Board has been postponed for holding the deferred Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination-1991.

could not be held there due to the April 29 cyclone that ravaged the coastal belt and later due to question leakage, is beginning today with about 1,30,000 candidates appearing.

The HSC Examination of the Comilla Board has been scheduled for September 12.

A total of 89,422 candidates from Dhaka Board will sit for the HSC Examination to be held at 158 centres, including two abroad, the board sources said. Of the total, 63,441 are male and 25,981 female.

Some 50,320 candidates, including 36,660 male and 13,113 female, will appear at the HSC examination from Jessore Board.

The Board to ensure peaceful holding of the examination has opened 128 centres in addition to 10 sub centres.

More than 70,000 candidates are appearing from Rajshahi Board this year.
