

53.04 p.c. pass HSC exams

Results of Higher Secondary School Certificate (HSC) examinations under four education boards of the country were announced on Sunday.

A total number of one lakh 24 thousand eight hundred and seventy-three candidates appeared at the examination from four education boards of which one lakh one thousand five hundred and sixty-one came out successful. The percentage of pass in general is 53.04 A K M Abdul Aziz Shibli of Rajshahi Cadet College with 926 marks to his credit topped the combined merit list of four education boards.

In Dhaka Board a total number of 55 thousand four hundred and twenty three candidates appeared at the examinations of which 30 thousand seven hundred and twenty came out successful. The percentage of pass is 55.43. Out of the successful candidates three thousand and fortyseven secured First Division, 14 thousand one hundred and eightyfour secured Second Division and 13 thousand four hundred and eighty-nine got Third Division.

In Comilla Board 41 thousand five hundred and thirty-seven appeared at the examinations of which 24 thousand one hundred and nine came out successful. The percentage of pass is 50.04.

Out of the successful candidates one thousand four hundred and fifteen secured First Division 11 thousand two hundred and twenty secured Second Division and 11 thousand four hundred and seventy four got Third Division.

In Rajshahi Board a total number of 42 thousand five hundred and thirty three appeared at the

examination of which 25 thousand two hundred and thirty came out successful. The percentage of pass is 59.31. Out of the successful candidates one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four secured First Division, 11 thousand five hundred and eleven secured Second Division and eleven thousand eight hundred and twenty-five got Third Division.

In Jessore Board 45 thousand three hundred and eighty appeared at the examination of which twenty one thousand five hundred and two came out successful. The percentage of pass is 87.38.

Out of the successful candidates one thousand three hundred and forty-two secured First Division, nine thousand four hundred and fifteen secured Second Division and 10 thousand seven hundred and forty-five got Third Division.
