

## HSC exams begin: 41 examinees expelled

The Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations of 1985 began all over the country under four education boards on Thursday. The first day of the examination was peaceful according to board sources.

The expulsion of 41 candidates under Dhaka, Comilla and Jessore Boards, for adoption of unfair means in the examination hall was reported till our going to the press late last night.

The Rajshahi Board authorities did not get any report of expulsion on the day, the Controller of Examinations of the board, said.

No untoward incident was reported from the four boards. The board authorities in cooperation with the local administrations had taken preparations for smooth conduct of the examinations.

Of the 41 expulsions reported on Thursday, six were from Dhaka Board 16 from Comilla Board and 19 from Jessore Board.

The Controller of Examinations of Dhaka Board said of the six expulsions reported to him by last night there was one expulsion each from the Jagannath College, Suhrawardy College, Dhaka College, and the

Bangla College centres in Dhaka city and two others from the Murapara centre in Narayanganj.

He said that he did not receive any report about any untoward incident. Reports from far-flung examination centres in mafussil areas, however, did not reach him till late last night.

The Controller of Examinations of Comilla Board said of the total 16 expulsions reported on the day four were from the Lalmani College three from

Comilla-2 seven from Debidwar and two others from the Comilla-4 centre.

JESSORE

Our Jessore Correspondent reported: The examinations under the board were more or less peaceful. The examinations at the Jessore Government College, however, started 30 minutes behind the schedule as there was a shortage of police escorts to take question papers to the centre on time. The examinations at the city college and the mahila college centres started 15 minutes behind the schedule for the same reason.

Of the 19 expulsions reported under the board, seven were from the Darshana Government College centre, three each from Keshabpur and Monrampur centres, two each from Chuadanga Govt. College and M M City College centres; and one each from Jhenidah K C College and B L College centres.

RAJSHAH

Our Rajshahi Correspondent reported: The examinations under the Rajshahi Board passed off peacefully and no untoward incident was reported, according to the Controller of Examinations of the board.

The board authorities did not receive any report of expulsion till late last night.
