

56.44 pc pass HSC examinations

The overall percentage of pass in the Higher Secondary Certificate examinations of 1986 under the four education boards of the country is 56.44, according to the results announced simultaneously on Friday.

In all a total of 2,63,249 candidates had appeared at the examinations from the four Education Boards of Dhaka, Comilla, Jessore and Rajshahi. Of them, 1,48,578 came out successful with 13,508 in the first division, 82,916 in the second division and 52,154 in third division.

The percentage of pass was the highest (62.27) under Rajshahi, on page 8 col. 3

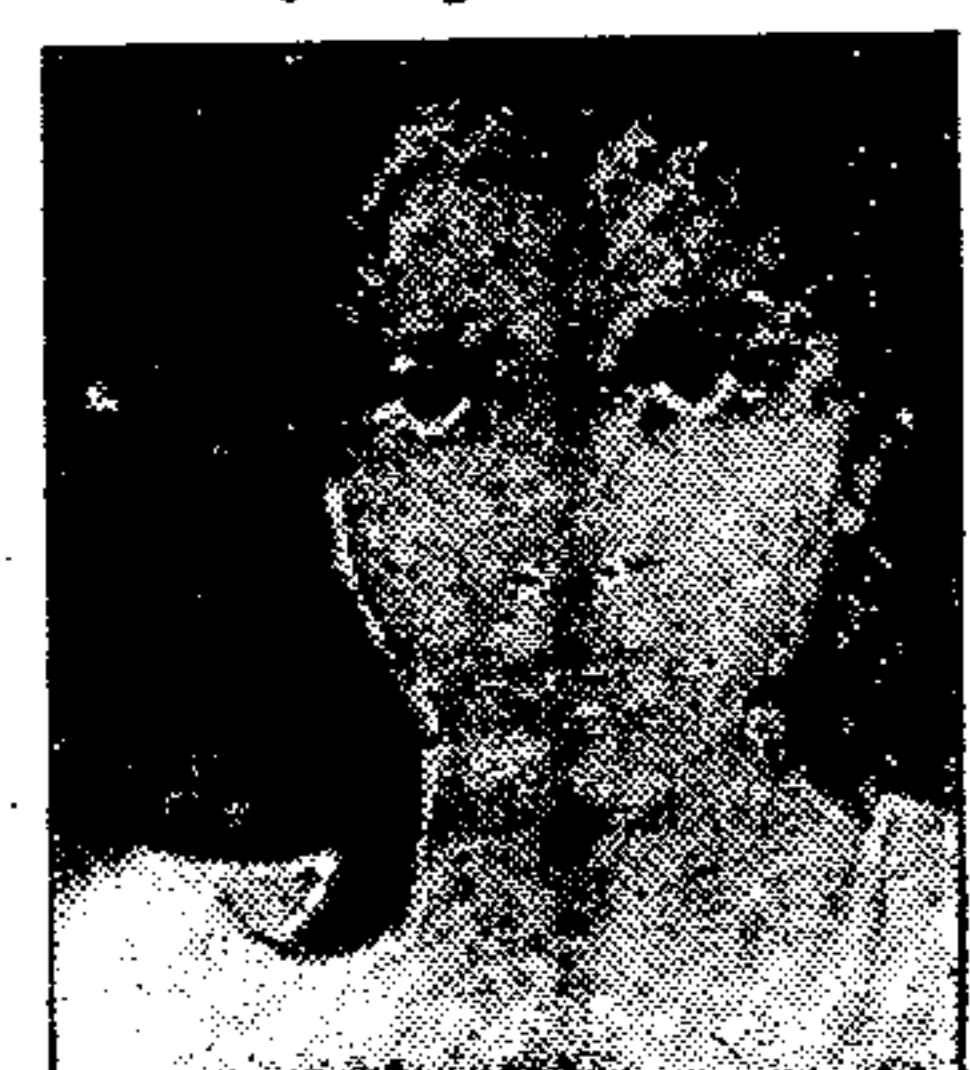

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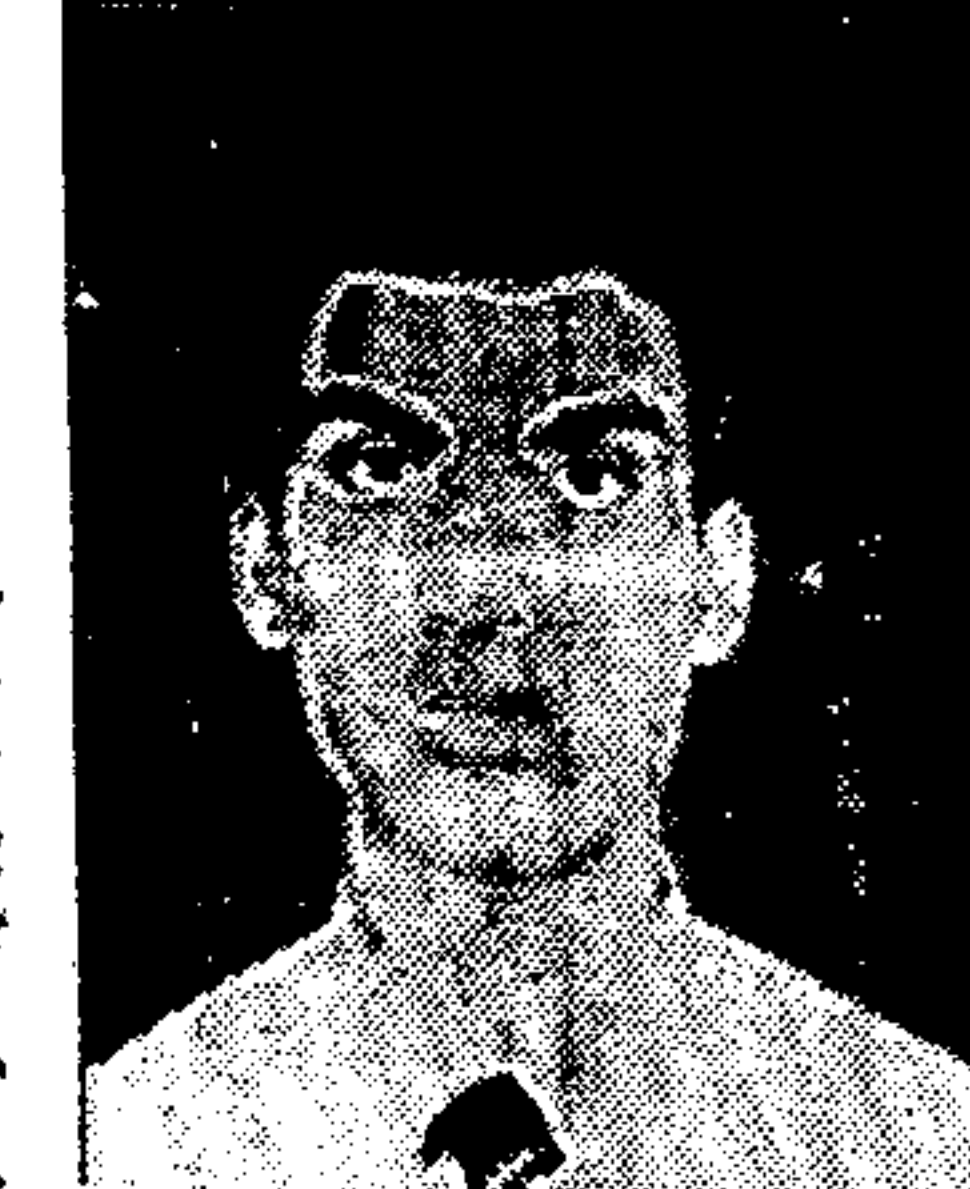

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shahi Board, followed by 61.69 under Comilla Board, 56.46 under Jessore Board and 48.42 in Dhaka Board.

The results were announced at an informal gathering of newsmen by Education Secretary Qazi Azhar Ali at the Education Ministry in the forenoon. The boards also simultaneously announced the results by sending results sheets to different centres under them.

Compared to other boards, the number of candidates was the highest under Dhaka Board. In this board out of 81,427 examinees 39,427 passed the examination. Of them, 5,667 secured first division, 23,125 second division and 10,635 third division.

Out of 55,339 candidates who appeared under Comilla Board, 34,140 came out successful with 2,489 in first division, 17,420 in second division and 14,231 in third division.

In Jessore Board 36,519 out of 64,674 candidates pass the examination, 2,444 were placed in first division, 20,924 in second division, and 13,151 in third division.

In Rajshahi Board out of 61,809 candidates, 38,492 passed the examination with 2,906 in first division, 21,447 in second division and 14,137 in third division.

Out of the total candidates under the four boards 22.55 per cent were female candidates. And compared to the overall pass percentage the percentage of pass of female candidates was higher (56.44 per cent and 56.62 respectively).

A total of 33,615 out of 59,360 male candidates passed the examinations, 2,621 being in first division, 18,449 in second division, and 12,545 in third division.

The number of female candidates was highest (20,169) under Dhaka Board, followed by 15,153 under Jessore Board.
