

66.39 pc pass SSC exams

The overall percentage of pass in the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) Examinations of 1986 under the four Education Boards of the country is 66.39, according to the results announced simultaneously on Thursday.

Out of a total 3,66,381 candidates who had appeared in the examinations in March-April this year, 241,134 came out successful from all over Bangladesh.

In all 35,544 candidates secured First Division, 1,69,069 got Second Division while 36,521 candidates were placed in Third Division.

The results show that the percentage of pass was the

highest (71.96) under Comilla Board followed by 68.79 under Rajshahi Board, 66.66 under Jessore Board and 58.16 under Dhaka Board.

In the overall results of the four boards, boys did better than girls the respective percentage of pass being 66.44 and 64.29. Out of the total 3,66,381 candidates in all the four boards 1,06,788 were girls.

The largest number of candidates 1,11,660 had appeared under the Dhaka Education Board. 64,946 out of them passed the examinations with 10,305 in First Division, 46,911 in Second Division and 7,730 in Third Division.

In Comilla Board 60,668 out of a total of 84,304 candidates

passed the examination. Of them 10,062 were in First Division, 42,399 in Second Division and 8,207 in Third Division.

In Rajshahi out of total 89,679 candidates, 61,698 came out successful with 7,324 in First Division, 42,576 in Second Division and 11,798 in Third Division.

In Jessore Board out of 80,738 candidates 53,822 passed the examination. Of them 7,853 got First Division, 37,183 Second Division while 8,786 got Third Division.

This year candidates under all the four boards appeared under two different courses—the old course and the new one introduced since 1985. While the new course is a bit track-

one, the old course comprised a total of seven groups.

Under the old curriculum a total of 67,258 candidates had appeared at the examination of them 42,318 came out successful with 1,282 in First Division, 28,901 in Second Division and 12,135 in Third Division.

The percentage of pass of students appearing under the old curriculum were 50.77 in Dhaka Board, 68.52 under Comilla Board, 71.70 under Rajshahi Board and 62.29 under Jessore Board. The number of candidates appearing under the old course from these boards were 20,323; 11,436; 19,043 and 16,456 respectively.

Son of a retired officer of Bangladesh Krishi Bank Mr. D. M. Ahmed, Faisal wants to be a diplomat by profession.



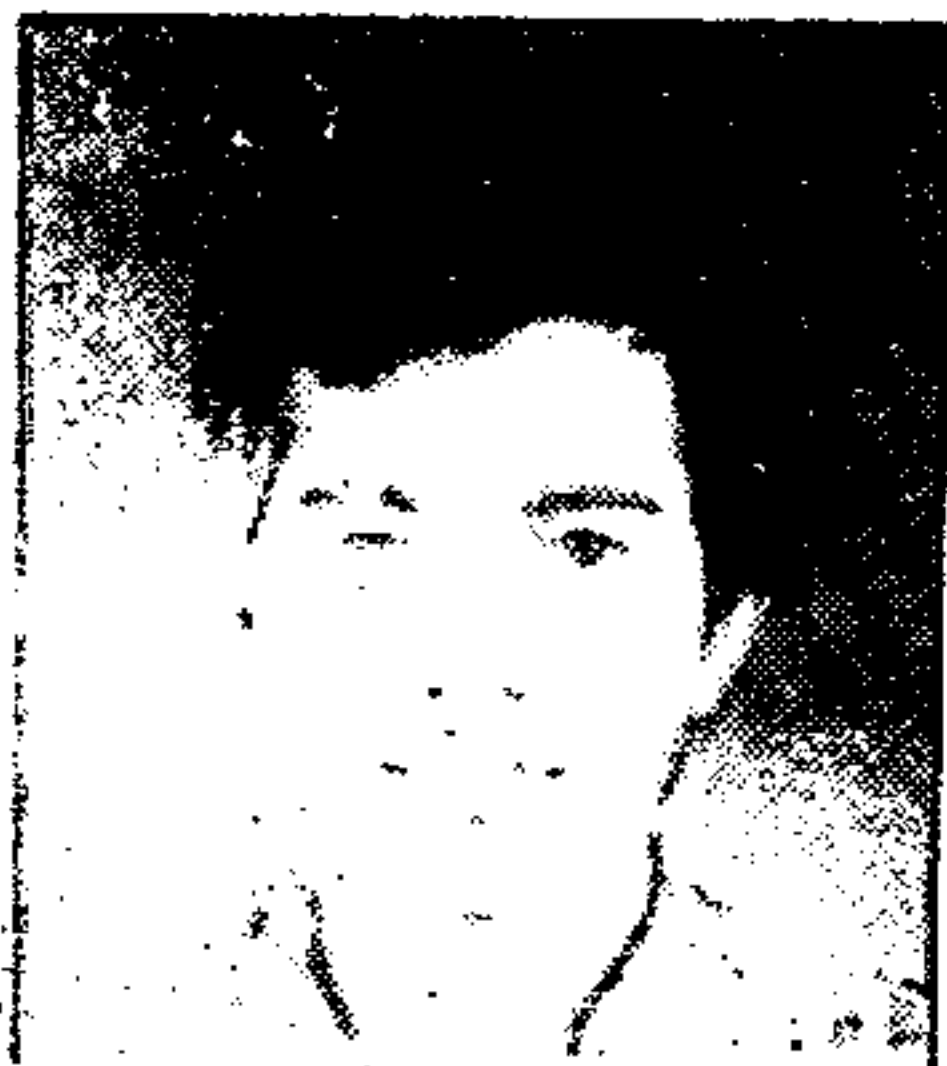
