Exam reforms body submits report

Prof. M. Shamsul Haque, Chairman of the Examination Reforms Committee today formally handed over its report to the Education Secretary Quazi Jalaluddin Ahmed at the concluding meeting of the committee for consideration of the government, reports BSS.

The 25-member committee which was formed on October 3, 1985, completed its report within the specified period of seven months fixed by the Government.

The Education Secretary told the meeting held at the Bangladesh Bureau of Educational Information and Statistics (BANBEIS) conference hall that the report would get immediate consideration of the Government and it was likely that an Implementation Committee would be set up soon to advise the Government for implementation of the recommendations made in the report.
