

## Exam system discussed

The Examination Reform Committee in a meeting on Friday discussed various aspects relating to improvement of the existing examination system at Secondary and Higher Secondary levels.

Presided over by Prof M Shamsul Huq, Chairman of the committee, the meeting held at Planning Academy in the morning was attended by about 50 professional experts including heads of different educational institutions in the city, senior teachers and scholars.

Speakers at the meeting, the fourth of its kind discussed problems faced by the students in the existing system of examination and put forward specific suggestions to reform the system.

Prof M Shamsul Huq said the overall improvement of the education system was a huge task and required sufficient time and money. He, however, suggested a reform within the existing limitations.
