

Stage set for holding SSC exams

All preparations have been complete for holding the Secondary School Certificate examinations under four education boards of the country from March 6, an official handout said in Dhaka on Saturday night reports BSS.

The government has taken necessary steps for conducting the SSC examinations peacefully and smoothly so that strike by the non-government school teachers does not hamper the examinations.

The handout said that the Deputy Commissioners would take up the overall responsibility of holding the SSC examinations in their respective districts. If necessary, the Deputy Commissioners would appoint secretary for each examina-

tion centre, and invigilator, for examination hall and reorganise the Centre Committee. Any Government officials, officials of the Primary Education Directorate, teachers of government and non-government colleges, teachers of government schools, experienced teachers of primary school, PTI staff or any other persons suitable for that job can be appointed, the handout said.

The district administrators would make sure that the centre Secretaries discharge their responsibilities properly. The district administration would ensure necessary security measures so that the centre authority could take delivery of the examination materials and question papers properly. Similarly, the Deputy Commissioners must take adequate steps to send the scripts to the Board of Secondary Examination with full security.

The district administration must take measures so that all candidates can collect their admit cards from their respective schools by March 3 and 4. If any students fail to take delivery of the admit cards from the schools arrangements would be made to give those from examination centres or sub-centres. Deputy Commissioners will take necessary steps in this regard.

If an examination centre or sub-centre is considered troublesome then alternative centre or sub-centre can be opened at nearby school, madrasah or college.

Instructions have been issued to submit the list of schools which will not cooperate in holding the SSC examinations to the Director General, Secondary and Higher Secondary Education Directorate and Education Ministry. Cooperation from the upazila chairmen in taken those measures would be accepted.

The Deputy Commissioner would be able to take any action, they will deem fit for smooth conducting of the examinations and maintaining security of the centres in their respective districts, the handout added.
