80 per cent. pass B. Ed examination

A total of 2,300 examinees out of 2,599 came out success ful in all subjects in the first semister of Bachelor in Education (B.Ed) in distance education with percentage of Pass being 80, according to the results announced in Dhaka on Friday, reports BSS.

The week-long examination which began on December 27 was conducted by computer. Neither any examiner nor any tabulator was engaged in the examination organised by the Fangladesh Institute of Distance Education (BIDE) according to an official handout.

This is for the first time in Bangladesh the results of a huge number of post graduate examinees were announced within three weeks. This system will help reduce the trend of unfairmeans in the examinations, the handout said.
