Mass copying in SSC Exam.

NILPHAMARI, Mar. 22: At least 381 Secondary School Certificate examinees including some females were expelled from six out of seven centres in Nilphamari district in the first three days of examinations for adopting unfair means.

A total of 3772 including 67 examinees at Saidpur Cantt. Public School Centre are appearing at the Secondary School Certificate Examinations in Nilphamari district. No untoward incident happened so far.

Pabna

Our Pabna Correspondent reports: With 79 more expulsions on March 20 of SSC examinees from nine centres throughout Pabna district the total expulsions during the last three days rose to 220 of whom 25 were girls.

Over 20 bagloads of incriminating papers were also recovered.

Fifteen invigilators were also expelled, 10 persons arrested for supplying copies to examinees at different centres.

Jhalakati

A report from Jhalakati adds: A total of 116 candidates were expelled from different centres of Jhalakati for adopting unfair means in the halls.

A report from Pirojpur adds: A total of 25 students were expelled from seven upazila centres in Pirojpur district on the first day of examination.

A report from Sherpur adds: One hundred and eleven more examinees and five invigilators were expelled from examination halls for adopting unfair means during the Mathematics examination in different centre of Sherpur district. The total number of expulsion rose to 341 during last three days. No untoward incident was however reported.

Gouripur

A report from Gouripur (Mymensingh) adds: A total of 47 SSC candidates were expelled from Gouripur SSC examination centre for adopting unfair means in Bengali first and second paper examination.

A total of 1022 students are appearing in the SSC examination from 17

high schools of Gouripur Upazila.

BSS from Rangpur reports: Two hundred and four candidates were expelled in the first two days for adopting unfair means in SSC examination in seven centres in the district.

It may be noted that 8149 candidates are appearing in SSC examination in 8 centres of the district. No candidates were expelled from Mithapukur centre, 22 from Pirojganj, 25 from Kaunia and 22 from Taraganj.

A report from Kushtia adds: One hundred and fifty-three SSC candidates were expelled during the English examination on Saturday in 16 centres of the district.

It may be mentioned that on the first day examination in Bengali, 123 candidates were expelled for adopting unfair means.

Maulvibazar

Our Maulvibazar correspondents writes: 22 students were expelled from Rajnagar upazila centre for adopting unfair means on the first day of the Secondary School Certificate (SSC) Examination under Comilla Education Board.

A total of 1700 SSC candidates are appearing at the 5 centres of Maulvibazar and Rajnagar upazilas.

Rajbari

The SSC examination '89 of Dhaka Board at Rajbari centre commenced peacefully.

A total of 1557 candidates including 551 girls from 15 schools of Rajbari sadar upazila are appearing at this centre. Seven candidates were absent on the first day of the examination. None was expelled.

Dakhil examination

NILPHAMARI:—In total 501 examinees including 28 females from 76 Madrasahs of Nilphamari district are appearing at the Dakhil Examination '89 which commenced here from March 9.

A total of 19 students were expelled on the first day for adopting unfair means in the examination. Mr Iqbal Hossain Khan ADC (Gen) Nilphamari visited the Nilphamari Alia Madrasah examination centre on the first day of the examination.
