## 57 pc pass Dhaka Board HSC exams

The results of Higher Secondary Certificate (HSC) examinations held in August-September this year under Dhaka Board, were announced officially yesterday (Saturday). The percentage of pass is 57.04.

A total of 49.104 candidates, out of 86,093 appeared, came outsuccessful. Of them 9,533 candidates secured first division, 19928 second division and 19643

Of the total candidates, 25173 were female of which 15,568 came out successful. The percentage of pass of the female students is 61.84 and that of male 55.05.

In the Science Group, a total 25,470 candidates sat for the examination of whom 15,735 came out successful. The percentage of success in this group is 61.77.

A total of 15,664 candidates appeared in Commerce Group of whom 10.234 came out successful. The percentage of pass is 65.33.

In the Arts Group, 44.412 students took part in the examinations of whom 22,787 were successful. The percentage of pass is 51.31 in this group.

In the Agriculture Group the total number of candidates appearing at the examinations was 194 of whom 54 came out successful with a 27.84 percent success. A total of 317 candidates sat for the examinations in the home economics of whom 269 were successful with a 84.86 percent success.
