67.58 pc pass Dhaka Board SSC exams

The results of the Secondary School Certificate Examination of the Board of Intermediate and Secondary Education, Dhaka held this year has been announced here yesterday (Monday), reports BSS.

A total of 1,00,027 candidates out of the total of 1,48,003 who had appeared came out successful. Of them, 19,023 got first division, 45,456 second division and 35,548 third division. The percentage of pass is 67.58.

Of the total appeared candidates, regular students were 1,34,662 while private students were 13,341. Among the regular candidates 87,243 were male students while 47,419 were female.

Among the private candidates who had appeared in the examination, 7,623 students were

male while 5,718 were female.

The percentage of the male students passed in the examination was 68.81 while that of the female students was 67.40.

Of the total 96,315 male students appeared, 65,276 students came out successful while female students numbering 34,751 out of total 53,857 came out successful in the examination.

Jalal Ahmad Mirza (roll Mirzapur Cadet 68205) of Mirzapur Cadet College, Tangail, clinched the first position of the merit list of the first 20 successful candidates with general science of the SSC examination of 1991 under Dhaka Board.

Jalal scored 887 marks with six letters in English, Mathematics, Geography, Islamiat, General

Science and Elective Mathematics while the second position with 871 marks including six letters in the same subjects went to Nazimuddin *Mohammad Wasiuddin (roll Mirzapur Cadet 68228) of the same college.

The third position with 867 marks including five letters went to Mohammad Tanvir Islam (roll Mirzapur Cadet 68226) of the same college. All the successful candidates of the merit list passed the examination with general science as their common subject and they all got star marks. A total of 14 students of the Mirzapur Cadet College came on the merit list both individually and jointly.

In the combined merit list with soil science as the common subject, Monishita Ghosh (roll Dhaka F 152485) of Udayan Biddalaya of Dhaka got the first position with 780 marks including three letters in Mathematics, Science and Book Keeping, the second position was scored by Mohammad Sabrin Munshi (roll Faridpur 94947) of Faridpur Zila School with 776 marks including four letters in Mathematics, Geography, Islamiat and Book Keeping.

The third position went to Mohammad Moazzem Hossain (roll Narayanganj 105865) of Delpara High School, Narayanganj with 775 marks including four letters in the same subjects.
