Despite strike by the nongovernment college teachers
degree pass examinations under
Dhaka and Chittagong
Universities were held peacefully
yesterday (Monday). The
examinations were held under the
special arrangement taken by the
government.

Deputy Commissioners, Magistrates and other government officials were deputed to conduct the examination.

Education Minister Barrister Jamiruddin Sircar said at a press conference that a total of 1.17,680 students, in 132 and 70 centres in Dhaka and Chittagong appeared on the first day of examination under special arrangements.

centres in the city over holding of
the examination peacefully with
the help of government, nongovernment teachers, officials,
guardians and student community.
Transport strike also failed to
distract the holding of the
examination, he added.

About 25,000 teachers of private colleges, schools and madrashas have been on strike since January 18 to press home their demands.

Education Minister referring to the demands of the striking teachers said, the government has in principle agreed to most of them. They include provision of a trust fund, introduction of salary index system and new service rules for the employees and repeal of directorate of inspection and audit system.

He also said, the government is considering other demands and added that about 1400 college teachers were promoted by 20th November last year. The cases of 1200 others are under active consideration of the authorities. He however, hoped that the strike would be withdrawn immediately after fruitful discussions and possible measures would be taken to solve session jam in the university.
