Attack on BCU procession at JU: 4 injured

Four activists of Bangladesh Chhatra Union (BCU) were injured when a group of pro-Awami League Chhatra League (BCL) workers attacked a BCU procession at Jahangirnagar University at around 11.30 pm on Thursday.

The injured were identified as Saikat Subhra, President of Chhatra Union JU unit, Aich Manan Meer Ahsan Habib and Shimul.

BCL workers equipped with firearms and iron rods attacked the BCU procession at Bhasani; hall. They also fired several rounds of gunshots during the attack.

BCU workers were protesting a decision of the JU authorities to raise meal charges.

The injured BCU activists were treated at JU medical centre and a clinic at Savar.
