BUET students go on rampage

A group of students of Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology allegedly went on rampage at the teachers quarters on the campus last night.

The agitators were demanding withdrawal of expulsion order against a student of Civil Engineering Department.

In the face agitation, the teachers and their families got out of the quarters for safety and staying there till the writing of this report at 12:30 am.

One of the teachers told The Daily Star over telephone that they had called police but did not respond.

The university authorities expelled the student concerned for two years as he had adopted unfair means in a class test about a month ago. The student appealed to the university's academic council to pardon him. The council then reduced the expulsion term to one year.

Dissatisfied at the decision, the students went on rampage.
