Chopping incident

DU student arrested

Police arrested a Dhaka University student on Sunday for his involvement in an incident of chopping another student at Suryasen Hall on Saturday.

A.B.M. Zakir Hossain, a student of Economics Department, chopped M. Phil research student of Finance and Banking Department Munshi Md. Selim while he was sleeping in his room.

Earlier a case was filed against Zakir and his associates. He was arrested from his sister's residence at Z/1 Salimullah Road Mohammadpur.

Meanwhile, President and General Secretary of Bangladesh Chhatra League's (BCL) DU unit Sajjad Hossain and A.K.M. Azim, in a joint statement condemned the terrorist act of Zakir and his group at the Suryasen Hall. They also demanded exemplary punishment to the criminals.

In the same statement, BCL leaders refuted the news items published by different national dailies which identified Zakir as a BCL activist.

They said that Zakir has no connection with BCL.
