## DU student chopped by rivals

A residential student of Sur-yasen Hall of Dhaka University was chopped by a group of identified cadre of the hall on Saturday noon.

M.Phil. research student of Finance and Banking Department Munshi Md. Selim had been admitted to the Dhaka Medical College Hospital and was in a critical condition.

Hall sources said that A.B.M. Zakir Hossain, a third year honours student of Economics Department along with his associates chopped Selim to take revenge as he (Zakir) was beaten by the students on Friday for allegedly having connection with a theft which took place at the hall during Eid vacation.

Selim was chopped when he was sleeping in his room (No. 468) at around 3:30 p.m.

Meanwhile, the university authorities have formed a three-member inquiry committee to investigate the incident and have temporarily suspended the alleged students until the submission of report by the committee.

The authorities, in a press release, identified the associates of Zakir as Shahidul Islam of the Islamic Studies Department, Md. Jamaluddin of Sociology Department, Mehdi Hasan of Management Department, Noman of Mohsin Hall and Khokon of Zahurul Haq Hall.
