Gunfight between BCL factions at DU hall: 3 hurt

Three people were injured during a gunfight between two factions of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL), at the Zahurul Haq Hall of Dhaka University, over the control of the hall on Thursday evening.

At least ten rounds of gunshots were fired when Shamim Group of BCL approached the hall to ust Babu, the man in control of the hall at present, and his group.

However, Shamim Group failed to take control over the hall as the activists of Babu group built a strong resistance.

During the trade of gunshot, Tahera Khatun (55), wife of a university staff, Ali Akber, an M. Phil Researcher of Islamic Studies Department, and Salauddin of Babu Group recieved

bullet injuries and were admitted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital.

Later police raided the hall. Shamim Ahmed was driven out of the hall by Babu, who defected from the Shamim Group, a few weeks back.

Sources said that yesterday's (Thursday) incident was sequel to the incident which took place the previous day at Plassy where Babu harassed Shamim and snatched his car and mobile Phone.

Meanwhile, incident of gunshot was took place at the Mohsin Hall's extension area near the new market on the same evening. At least seven rounds of gunshots were fired there, sources said.

Meanwhile, Dhaka University authorities have expelled Shamim Ahmed and Babu from the University temporarily.

A three member committee regarding this incident have been formed.
