26-member civilian cabinet sworn in

A 26-member Cabinet with Mizanur Rahman Chowdhury as Prime Minister was sworn-in yesterday barely 17 hours before the newly elected Parliament goes into session.

The new cabinet will have three deputy prime ministers-Barrister Maudud Ahmed, Prof M A Matin and Kazi Zafar Ahmed.

President Lt Gen H M Ershad administered the oath to the cabinet members at a simple ceremony in the magnificent Darbar Hall of Bangabhavan in the afternoon. The function was attended, among others, by the two deputy chief martial law administrators, former ministers, members of the diplomatic corps and high officials.

The four new faces inducted in the cabinet are Hashemuddin

Ahmed of Mymensingh, Mirza Ruhul Amin of Thakurgaon, Mominuddin Ahmed of Khulna and Maulana M.A. Mannan of Chandpur. They returned to parliament in the May 7 election on Jatiya Party ticket. Three sitting state ministers
