



# Barguna Women's College smarts under problems

BARGUNA, Nov. 19: Academic pursuit of Barguna Women's College is being hindered because of many problems facing the institution for long.

The number of classrooms is too few to accommodate the students. A number of scheduled classes are not taken although seminar and science-laboratory rooms are used as class rooms.

In the absence of an examination hall, classes are suspended during the examinations.

Out of the total sanctioned posts of teachers 14 have long been lying vacant, as such, the students are deprived of regular classes.

The tin shed of the college building has become worn-out allowing rain water to leak in that makes the kutcha floor muddy. In the days of profuse rainfall, the college sometimes remains closed.

There is no hostel in the college. As a result the girls who reside in Barguna town only can study in this institution.

At present, 250 students in HSC level and 35 in degree level are studying in the college. They can not carry out cultural and sport performances for want of auditorium and play-ground.

Our Chapainawabganj Correspondent writes: Chapainawabganj Shah Niamathulla College has been encumbered with many problems including

shortage of teachers, accommodation and furniture.

Established in 1979, the college is yet to be provided with hostel facilities for students, library, necessary science apparatus and play ground.

The existing class rooms are awfully small and fewer in number than the requirement.

At present, 16 teachers are working in the college. At least 12 more teachers need to be appointed to ensure regular classes.
