Lutful Haider Chowdhury dead

Eminent educationist and Chairman of National Syllabus and Textbook Board, Prof Lutful Haider Chowdhury died of a heart attack Friday night at his residence at Amanat Shah Road here. He was 55, reports BSS.

The Namaz-e-Janaza of Mr Chowdhury was held at Baitul Mukarram and he was laid to rest at Banani graveyard yesterday.



The Kulkhwani of Mr Chowdhury will be held on November 15 after Asr prayer at his 68/1 Amanat Shah Road (West Raza Bazar) residence.

Prof Lutful Haider Chowdhury started his career as a journalist in the Daily Sangbad. Later he joined the Education Department and served as professor in Chittagong College, Rajshahi College, Barisal B.M. College and Titumir College. He was also Principal of Khulna Government Women's College, Dhaka Residential Model College, Karatia Sadat University College and Government Shaheed Suhrawardy College.

He joined the National Syllabus and Textbook Board as chairman on October 13 last.

Mr Chowdhury was associated with Kendrio Kochi Kanchar Mela, Nazrul Shishu Shikshalaya and many other educational institutions of the country.

He left behind his wife and two sons.
