Most of city educational institutions reopen

Most of the educational institutions in the city reopened yesterday after a closure of long one month. Classes of the institutions were suspended on September I due to the devastating flood.

It is learnt that a number of schools and colleges in the city could not be reopened as the flood victims were still staying there.

Among these, classes resumed at Dhaka University, and Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology, (BUET).

Meanwhile, provosts of the halls of DU in a meeting reviewed the situation in the campus. The meeting with Prof Abdul Mannan, Vice Chancellor of the university, in the chair, decided to hold separate meetings with the leaders of Chhatra Sangram Parishad and Islami Chhatra Shibir to discuss the recent eviction of the Shibir members from different halls.

It may be mentioned that the anti-Shibir student organisations have been beating and evicting the Shibir members from the DU halls following killing of a Chhatra League (S-R) worker at Sylhet on September 24.
