

# Gun shots on DU campus

Gun shots rocked the Dhaka University campus yesterday after a Chhatra League (A-A) worker, Tuhin, was beaten up allegedly by Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) workers yesterday noon.

Chhatra League is the student wing of the opposition Awami League and JCD that of the ruling Bangladesh Nationalist Party (BNP).

Witnesses said JCD workers began to chase Tuhin, a first year student at the Department of Management, immediately after he came out from the Registrar Office. Tuhin was caught near the residence of the Vice Chancellor and beaten up. It was at this time some eight rounds of gun shots were fired from Zahurul Haq Hall.

Police had to lob three rounds of tear gas shells to bring the situation under control but tension was prevailing on the campus till late in the evening.

The brief violence was the first such incident on the campus after the two student groups on Saturday assured Vice Chancellor Prof Moniruzzaman Miah that they would refrain from violent and provocative activities.

**Jhenidah**

UNB adds from Jhenidah: Five students were injured in a clash between activists of Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal and Jatiya Chhatra Dal at Kaliganj Mahatabuddin College yesterday (Sunday).

The rival groups clashed at an electioneering meeting for the ensuing student union election, scheduled for December 31, campus sources said.

They fought with stones and sticks and blamed each other for the attack.

The injured were given first aid in local health complexes.

Later in the evening, Jatiya Chhatra Dal held a protest rally at Kaliganj bus stand.
