

JN Varsity teachers to join duty Oct 17

Teachers of Jahangirnagar University on Thursday decided to join duty on October 17 after a 78-day of work abstention.

The Jahangirnagar University Teachers' Association (JUTA) took this decision at a meeting on Thursday considering the government steps regarding an amicable solution to the problem of the university and greater of the students.

Teachers of Jahangirnagar University went on work abstention for an indefinite period on July 29 in

The meeting, held at the university central cafeteria with JUTA President Prof. Mustahidur Rahman in the chair, demanded immediate arrest and trial of all persons against whom the authorities have filed cases under Anti-Terrorism Law.

The meeting also demanded publication of the enquiry commission report on the violent incident of July 29 in time.
