## BEL submits memorandum to DU V-C

Bangladesh Chhatra League (M-I), on Saturday staged demonstration in front of Dhaka University V-C's office and submitted a memorandum to V-C Prof. Emazuddin Ahmed protesting invitation of Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia to the special convocation.

Addressing a gathering at the foot of Aparajeo Bangla, BCL leaders said Prime Minister Begum Khaleda Zia was committed to implementing the demands of students but no effective measures were taken by her Government in this regard as yet.

They said if any positive announcement was not made by the Prime Minister, the students of Dhaka University would not allow her on Dhaka University campus.

They criticised the University authorities for the decision to invite the Prime Minsiter to the special convocation ignoring the sentiment of

students and warned the DU administration not to take position against the general students.

Later, leaders and workers of BCL went to the V-C's office in a procession and staged demonstration there. A delegation led by BCL President Moinuddin. Hasan Chowdhury met V-C Prof. Emazuddin Ahmed and submitted a memorandum.

GCO, a combined body of nine left leaning student organisations and Chhatra Oikkya Forum held separate rallies on University campus protesting the invitation of the Prime Minister to Dhaka University special convocation.

GCO held the rally at the main gate of Curzon Hall which was addressed among others by Ragib Ahsan Munna and Abu Aslam Mintu.

They said the students of Dhaka University would not allow the Prime Minister on University campus if any positive announcement was not made by her before coming to the University.
