Police, students clash in Rajshahi: 30 hurt

RAJSHAHI, Nov. 6:—At least 30 students including five teachers were injured in a clash between police and members of Anti-Communal Students Society (ACSS) in Rajshahi college this noon.

The college authorities suspended all classes till November 10 to avert any further untoward incident.

The injured teachers are Azizur Rahman of Economics, Tajul Islam of Accounting, Hamid Hossain of Botany and Sultana Rajia Begum.

According to witnesses, the clash ensued when activists of ACSS who gave a strike call for indefinite period in the college on November 2 demanding publication of admission test marks of eleven classes, tried to present students from entering the

classrooms.

The attackers ransacked the Principal's office room and damaged furniture. Police resorted to baton charge and fired teargas shells to disperse the mob.

Of the injured students, Tuhin, Rabiul Hossain, Shahriar, Runu and Mukul were admitted to Rajshahi medical college hospital.

The Principal has conveyed an emergency meeting on November 8 to review the situation.

Jamaat sources here claimed that the JCD activists also attacked its office at Jhikargachha and set fire to a motorcycle and furniture in the office.

They said that thema Jamest Ameer Ashraful Alam (29) and 10 other party activists were injured during the attack.
